This print contains instructions for the generation of an artwork. They are easily followed by a suitably skilled reader.

The Portable Document Format (PDF) was developed by Adobe Systems Incorporated in the United States of America and released in 1993 as a universal means of exchanging and viewing documents. The majority of the text was written directly in the PDF though in order to maintain accuracy a custom computer program was used to generate the cross-reference table.
